- Testing Framework: Create testing plan, testing cases to support product validation of new products
- Prototype Testing: Coordinate testing and debugging of hardware, firmware and apps with internal and external parties
- Testing Equipment: Coordinate purchasing of parts and components and building of test jigs
- Defect Tracking: Prepare failure analysis reports in the defect tracking system describing test failures and defects
- Laboratory Work: Using hot air and soldering equipment to re-work and modify prototypes for debugging
- Firmware Testing: Programming prototypes with latest firmware files and testing it in different use case scenarios for stability and potential bugs
- Internal Communication: Collaborate with R&D team to provide timely solution for resolving defects to ensure project can be accomplished on schedule
- New Product Monitoring: Monitoring new products post launch and analyzing customer satisfaction and return trends
- Product Manuals: Reviewing and editing content for specifications in product manuals and continually updating
- Competitor Product Evaluation: Testing, evaluating and reporting on competitor sample products
